- Participate in shop clean up and organization projects as assigned.
- Assist in maintenance and repairs to tools and scene shop.
- Participate in all Load-In and Strikes of shows.

- Previous experience in a scene shop desired.

- Good carpentry skills.
- Able to lift heavy scenery.
- Able to work at 14'-0" high.
- Welding a plus, but not necessary.
- Theatrical Rigging knowledge a plus, but not necessary.
- Interpret and understand construction and designer drawings.
- A positive attitude.
- Good communication skills.
- The ability to finish a project thoroughly – with attention to detail.
