




FROM THE CO-FOUNDER

Every year, I hope the holiday season becomes the "Best Christmas Ever." From decorating the LAC to opening *Christmas Canteen* and *A Christmas Carol*, I want everything to be perfect. At home, I love decorating our trees. (One tree is solely dedicated to musical instruments.) As I pull out every ornament, I yell to Anthony who is usually in the kitchen, "Look at this one. It's my absolute favorite." My parents and I started getting Anthony Santa ornaments 28 years ago because he said he loved Santa one day in passing. I will admit my family went a little overboard.

Almost every year, one of these treasured pieces shatters. I become distraught, just like the mom in Tony DiTerlizzi's children's book, The Broken Ornament. I set up the Santa Hospital, where I use various glues, ribbons, and tweezers to repair and rehang. In the book, Jack breaks one into a million glittery pieces and says, "It's just a junky old ornament. We will get another one."

Then the book beautifully recounts why it is impossible to replace what is lost.



This Christmas, I feel like one of those shattered baubles. I just don't have the Christmas spirit. My mother Carolyn is now in assisted living, where I have set up my temporary office. She is my personal Christmas ornament. And when you ask about her, you mend her in the most beautiful ways.

Many of you in our audience are working to glue your cherished ornament back together too. What a blessing that so many of you share with me your health struggles, your challenges, and your losses. Carolyn has given me the gift of what it feels like to be broken and keep going.

Aurora needs more than a little glue and ribbon this season. Theatres all across the nation have closed, and Georgia is 50th in arts funding. Our ticket sales are wonderful. People are coming in droves to see our shows and attend our concerts. While *Christmas Canteen* plays our Grand Stage, there is something happening in all 4 of our spaces all the time and that requires staff to set up,



tear down, sell tickets, and man the bar. Plus, as a professional theatre, we are committed to artist compensation. We employ more than 250 actors, technicians, and musicians each year. But the fact is it is very expensive to operate the LAC campus. It costs \$500,000 a year to keep the lights on, make sure it is clean, safe, warm or cool.

To help Aurora continue our vital work, we received a challenge grant; an angel willing to match your kindness. So this holiday, please consider 2 things:

- 1. Buy two Mini Season Tickets to give friends to join you for every show.
- 2. Please consider an end of year gift so that we can continue to bring you the irreplaceable, original shows handmade by Atlanta artists.

When you come to *Christmas Canteen* or any other Aurora show, you get something you cannot get anywhere else – **MAGIC**. 

An education major at James Madison University, she used her background to develop Aurora's Learning Library (or L2). As a musician, she created Aurora's Musicals by Moonlight, and Aurora's New Musical Initiative. She has performed as pianist and music director both nationally (Goodspeed Opera House, Pasadena Playhouse, The Cleveland Playhouse, The Kennedy Center) and locally (The Alliance, Theatrical Outfit, Horizon Theatre, Georgia Ensemble Theatre). As a proud citizen of Gwinnett, Ann-Carol is most proud of Aurora Theatre winning the first ever Pinnacle Award for Large Non-Profit, and the first ever Moxie Award (for woman-led businesses) for Aurora Theatre. These distinctions go well with her 5 Suzi Awards for Outstanding Music Direction. She was a participant in the 2016 Atlanta Regional Commission's Regional Leadership Institute and member of the "Best Class Ever!"



He currently serves on various boards, both nationally and locally, including Georgia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, National Alliance for Musical Theatre (Vice President), Theatre Communications Group, the Citizens Advisory Board for Gwinnett Clean and Beautiful, and the Advisory Board for Public Broadcasting Atlanta which includes the NPR station WABE and PBS station PBA30. Anthony is a past Chair of the Gwinnett Chamber of Commerce, the first Latino and first Arts Leader to hold that position. He served as Vice Chair of Arts for the Chamber and Chair of Partnership Gwinnett and serves on the National Steering Committee for the Latinx Theatre Commons. Anthony is a graduate of the Atlanta Regional Leadership Commission's Regional Institute, Leadership Atlanta (#2classes) and the National Association of Latino Arts and Cultures' Leadership Institute and Advocacy Institute. Anthony, born in New York, and raised in Atlanta, graduated from the University of Georgia with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre. He resides in Duluth with his partner in life, Ann-Carol Pence, and their dog Bella.






